#### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP - BASENJIS AND WHIPPETS ONLY

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. **Stud Dog Class:** For Stud Dogs and their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. The Futurity Stake is exclusively for the competition of Basenji puppies, six (6) months and under eighteen (18) months of age at the date of the Futurity. Only puppies from nominated bitches, and with enrollment kept up-to-date, are eligible for the futurity stake at the show. Division must be noted on entry blank as an additional class.

ALL PUPPIES ENTERED IN THE FUTURITY MUST BE ENTERED IN THE REGULAR CLASSES OR BEST OF BREED OF THE EVERGREEN BASENJI CLUB SPECIALTY SHOW AND ENTERED IN THE FUTURITY AS AN "ADDITIONAL CLASS."
