Best Junior Handler – Will receive an award of \$300 at the annual Awards banquet from the Gary B. Jones Memorial Award Fund

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS & SPECTATORS

- All Regulations governing the use of this facility and all regulations and decisions of the Show Committee will be strictly enforced, including any not recorded in this Premium List.
- Certain areas at ringside will be reserved for SCA 2016 sponsors and Judges Education viewing. Noneligible spectators are expected to respect these areas and avoid using them. Non-eligible spectators will be asked to relocate if found viewing from the reserved area(s).
- Trophies not awarded or claimed at the show at which they are won become the property of the showgiving Club. The Club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value if any prize listed or described becomes unavailable. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - none will be mailed.
- All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.
- Oregon laws states that smoking is not allowed in the show buildings nor within 10 feet of any doorway
 or intake vent. This rule also applies to all e-cigarettes, as well.
- This Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

- There will be no refund for duplicate entries.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs allowed in rings during judging, special event, or demonstrations only. Dogs must be ready for
 judging. Neither the Club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for
 notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding
 up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

RESERVED GROOMING

- The show site will be available for exhibitors to set up their reserved grooming spaces by 2:00 pm, Monday, October 10, 2016. Dogs and all personal belongings must be removed from the show site by 10:00 PM. Saturday. October 15, 2016.
- Dogs may NOT be left overnight in the grooming area. The building will open each day at 7:00 am and be locked at 11:00 pm. Anyone not removing their dogs by the posted closing time will be charged \$5.00/dog per minute for every minute they are late removing the animal(s).
- The number of reserved grooming spaces is limited. Spaces will be assigned in the order received. No
 phone or email reservations will be taken. Requests for reserved spaces together must be submitted
 together, see website or packet for further information on the reserved grooming.
- . No crates will be allowed at ringside.
- Exercise pens may not be set up in the show building, on the concrete pads surrounding the building(s)
 or on the central grass area outside the show building.
- A limit of two 15 amp dryers may be operated simultaneously in any one 60 sq. ft. grooming space (three in a 120 sq. ft. grooming space). Power will be provided to each paid grooming space. Personal extension cords in aisles are avoided for safety reasons.
- Non-reserved, non-powered grooming will be allowed in the designated area only. You may be
 asked to stack your crates and there will be no saving of grooming space and no mats allowed in
 the designated free grooming area. The Show Committee reserves the right to limit the number of
 grooming tables per handler in the designated free grooming area. Tables and equipment may be left
 in the non-reserved grooming area overnight at owner's own risk.
- Cleanup of all grooming areas will be the owner's responsibility, and will be policed daily. Exhibitors will be responsible for maintaining clean conditions around their grooming area. Exhibitors are to bring their own equipment for clean up.
- Blowing out of chalk, talc, powder or other particulate grooming products with a force-air dryer in the building is prohibited. A designated outdoor area with table and force-air dryer will be available for use. Drying after bathing is allowed in the indoor grooming area.
- Dogs are not permitted in the rest rooms, food and/or shower areas.
- Neither the show-giving Club nor the host site will be responsible for the safety or well-being of dogs
 or other property left at the site.
- The show committee has the right to remove or have removed anything found to be blocking or obstructing the aisles.
- All passageways must be kept open; chairs, grooming and crates are not allowed in walkways. Aisles
 will be marked for easy access. Aisles, grooming and crating areas will be designated.
- After loading and unloading vehicles must be moved to the parking area. No parking is allowed immediately adjoining the loading and unloading area.
- The Reserved Grooming Committee will be the arbitrator of all issues with respect to reserved grooming. They will have the authority to expel anyone from the grooming area or to call an event committee on any individual(s) who choose not to comply with the rules. Their decisions will be final.

Dogs and Bitches must be registered on a Full Registration with the AKC (Limited Registration, ILP, and PAL numbers, and Foreign Registration cannot be accepted) and be intact (Per AKC rules, dogs may not be neutered nor bitches be spayed). Have an SCA Working title (WS, WSX or WSXM), an AKC Tracking title, or an AKC Performance Event Title that required at least three qualifying scores. (included but not limited to obedience, rally, agility, herding, etc.). Any other AKC certifications, tests and titles based on pass/fail scores do not qualify (example CGC, CA, HIT, THD). A verification list of eligible dogs/bitches may be obtained from the SCA Working Committee Chairperson. Champions of Record that have working titles are also eligible.

Winners of the Veteran Classes and Working Classes may compete for Best of Breed competition IF otherwise undefeated in the regular or non-regular classes at the show.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES)

Note: As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two to four of their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. The Get MUST be entered and shown in one of the Regular Classes at this show. The Stud Dog is the ONLY dog to be listed on the entry form and must be shown in the ring with his Get. Awards will be based on the merits of the Get. The Stud Dog and Get shall be considered as one entry for determining entry fees for this class. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular or additional conformation, obedience, or agility classes, or in Best of Breed competition, if eligible, in which case Stud Dog shall be considered a second class of the same dog requiring an entry fee of \$28.00. If entered only in Stud Dog Class, the fee shall be the regular entry fee of \$30.00. No Stud Dog or his Get may be shown as part of another unit.

Brood Bitch Class: For Brood Bitches and two to four of their Produce. Owner of Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of Produce. The Produce MUST be entered and shown in one of the Regular Classes at this show. The Brood Bitch is the ONLY dog to be listed on the entry form and must be shown in the ring with her Produce. Awards will be based on the merits of the Produce. The Brood Bitch and Produce shall be considered as one entry for determining entry fees for this class. The Brood Bitch may be entered separately in one of the regular or additional conformation, obedience, or agility classes, or in Best of Breed competition, if eligible, in which case Brood Bitch shall be considered a second class of the same dog requiring an entry fee of \$28.00. If entered only in Brood Bitch Class, the fee shall be the regular entry fee of \$30.00. No Brood Bitch or his Produce may be shown as part of another unit.

Brace Class: The Brace Class shall be for two dogs of at least one identical owner or co-owner regardless of sex. The two dogs comprising the Brace shall be considered a unit and they must be named at time of entry. If a dog, which is to be part of a brace is not entered in a regular class, or Best of Breed Competition, the dog must be entered for "Brace Class Only." In making entries for Brace Class Only, full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a brace, MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for ADDITIONAL CLASSES – "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH brace must be designated, "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. Please submit Brace entries together. Team Class: Same as for Brace Class, except it will be for four dogs of the same breed, with at least one identical owner or co-owner.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this



competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book, and the catalog.

Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner-handler for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series throughout the breed level competition for the show. This includes the class competition and subsequent competition in the breed ring. Additionally, dogs must be handled by and eligible owner-handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition. If the replacement handler is an eligible owner-handler for that dog, a change can occur. Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and winners of the non-regular classes.

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised, or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the week.

AKC SANCTIONED BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION Beginner Puppies (4-6 months of age)

Section 1- Classifications. The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility. Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule. if offered.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must
 be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who
 belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise
 advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may
 not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

Entry Fee: \$15.00 (including AKC recording fee of \$2.00 for each dog. These fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.)

Entries will close Wednesday NOON, Pacific Daylight Time, September 21, 2016 at Superintendent's office.

AWARD OF MERIT

At the discretion of the judge, an Award of Merit Plaque, offered by the Samoyed Club of America, Inc. may be given up to 10% (always rounded downward) of all those competing for Best of Breed. The 10% figure shall be based on the total Best of Breed entry at the time of closing, i.e., disregarding absentees or transfers from the classes, plus two for Winners Dog and Winners Bitch, plus an additional number for each winner of the following classes: All 3 Veteran Dog Classes, All 3 Veteran Bitch Classes, Working Dog, and Working Bitch. All those in Best of Breed competition shall be eligible to receive a Merit Award, except the Best of Breed Winner, the Best of Opposite Sex Winner, the Grand Champion Select Dog, and the Grand Champion Select Bitch.

DIVISION OF ENTRY MONEY AS PRIZES

The division of stakes will be made between the breeder, owner, and the owner of the sire, with the following proportions: the breeder is to receive 50% of the stake, the owner is to receive 35%, and the owner of the sire is to receive 15%.

The expenses of the Futurity will be deducted up to a maximum of 35% from the Futurity Stake, the remainder of the stake will be awarded to the winning Samoyed in the following proportions: The Grand Futurity Winner will receive 20% of the stake, the Best Futurity Puppy (6 - 12 months) and the Best Futurity Junior (12 months and over) will each receive 10%, the winner of the Intersex judging of each age division will receive 10%, and the Reserve Winner 5%.

SCA FUTURITY FLIGIBILITY

Nominations to the Futurity are open only to breeders who are active members in good standing of the Samoyed Cub of America, Inc. The bitch whose litter is nominated must be owned, co-owned, or leased by a Samoyed Club of America, Inc. member. This requirement does NOT apply to the owner(s) of any eligible puppies, nor to the owner(s) of the sire.

To be eligible to compete in the Futurity, a Samoyed must meet the following requirements:

- · Be from a litter, which was properly and timely nominated
- · Have been individually nominated before it reached the age of four months
- Be properly entered in one of the regular classes at the National Specialty or Obedience Trial
- Not be bred, or ever owned, co-owned, or leased by this year's judge, or member of his immediate
 family, nor sired by or out of a Samoyed ever owned, co-owned, or leased by this year's judge or
 member of his or her immediate family.

(Eligible puppies for this Futurity will include those born on or after March 23, 2015 and up to and including April 11, 2016).

JUDGING PROCEDURE

Each age division will be divided by sex. The judge will judge males first, then females of each age division in order, and will make four placements for each sex. The judge will then select an Intersex Winner and Reserve Winner for that age division. (These can be the same sex.)

When the first two age divisions have been judged, the winner of the 6-9 Months Division will compete against the winner of the 9-12 Months Division for the title of the BEST FUTURITY PUPPY.

After the third and fourth age divisions have been judged, the winner of the 12 – 15 Months and the 15 Months & Over division will compete for the title of BEST FUTURITY JUNIOR.

The Best Futurity Puppy will then compete with the Best Futurity Junior for the title of GRAND FUTURITY WINNER.

Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.
