Winners of the Veteran classes, if undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed Dogs/Bitches entered in Veterans may be spayed or neutered.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records.

GRAND CHAMPION SELECT: When quality warrants, after Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex are awarded, a Select Dog (SD) and Select Bitch (SB) may be chosen from the remaining Champions (Non Regular Class winners that are Champions and Qualify for BOB are eligible) - (WD or WB are not eligible) (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 3, Section 14, Effective 5-12-10)

AWARD OF MERIT: Five Award of Merits may be presented in addition to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and AKC Select Awards. The Judge may at his or her discretion, award all or none of the Rosettes.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY: All dogs entered in the Bred-By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. Best Bred by Exhibitor will be selected from the first place winners of each Bred by Exhibitor Class following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition.

BEST PUPPY CLASS ELIGIBILITY: Best Puppy will be selected from the first place winners from each Puppy Class (6-9 mo., 9-12 mo.) following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition.

BEST VETERAN CLASS ELIGIBILITY: Best Veteran will be selected from the first place winners of each Veterans Class following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries)

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

STUD DOG CLASS and BROOD BITCH CLASS: Each entry is allowed two get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

BRACE CLASS: Entry Fee \$15 per dog using two (2) complete entry forms, one for each dog in brace. Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

CHALLENGE TROPHIES

*Challenge Trophies are offered through the generosity of the listed donors only at the **AMERICAN WHIPPET CLUB WESTERN SPECIALTY**. They must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog or at consecutive shows for permanent possession. The Challenge Trophies will remain in the club's custody until retired, unless otherwise stated.*

BEST OF BREED: The Am/Can Ch. Brushwood Moxi of Endeavor Challenge Trophy (ceramic Whippet figure on wooden base) offered by Dr. Dennis Sumara, Linda Stewart and Angie Diehl. The trophy will remain in the donors' custody until it is retired.

BEST OF BREED: The Ch. Runners' He's The Continental, ROMX Memorial Challenge Trophy (Antique Silver Plated Bowl), originally offered by Isabell Stoffers,(Runners). This trophy was retired by Ch. Brush- wood Moxi of Endeavor in 2009 and was re-offered in 2010 by "Team Moxi".

BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX: The Farvel Memorial Challenge Trophy offered by Frederica Page Brant in loving memory of all her Farvel Whippets.

BEST PUPPY: Wooden plaque offered by Christy Nelson (Runners.)

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR: Isabell Stoffers of Runners Whippets Memorial Challenge Trophy offered by Christy Nelson (Runners). Flemish Tapestry Plate "The Hunt of The Unicorn" set in a shadow box frame with plaque.

FIRST BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG: The Ch. Runners' He's The Continental, ROMX, Memorial Challenge Trophy (Silver Plate Tray) Offered by Isabell Stoffers (Runners).

FIRST BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH: The Ch. Runners' Our Own Charisma, ROM, Memorial Challenge Trophy (Silver Plate Tray). Offered by Isabell Stoffers (Runners).

SET UPS / GROOMING – No crates, carts with crates, grooming tables, exercise pens or canopies will be allowed in the aisles. These setups are to be in designated areas only. Exhibitors are reminded that they are responsible for cleaning up their own grooming area.

GENERATORS – THERE IS NO POWER ON THE SHOW GROUNDS (except for overnight RV hook ups) BRING YOUR OWN GENERATOR IF NEEDED. No generators are allowed to be operated within 60' of any show ring after the start of judging and until all judging has been completed.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Open to all Whippets at least six months of age and under eighteen months of age on the date of the show, who are NOT Champions of Record. Champions of Record are not eligible to compete. Each Whippet must be entered in a regular class with the entry made at the same time and on the same form as the regular entry with "Puppy Sweepstakes Class" denoted in the "Additional Class" space on the entry form.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION

Puppy Sweepstakes is divided by sex:

6 & under 9 mos. • 9 & under 12 mos. • 12 & under 15 mos. • 15 & under 18 mos
Bred By Exhibitor (BBE) Puppy 6-18 Months

Each class winner competes for Best in Puppy Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES PRIZES

Entry Fees for Puppy Sweepstakes will be distributed as follows:

First - 25% • Second - 20% • Third - 15% • Fourth - 10%

Thirty Percent (30%) will be retained by the AWC for expenses.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes classes are open to all Whippets, who, on the day of the show, will be at least 7 years of age. All entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in a regular class at this show. Veteran Sweepstakes classes will be judged prior to the regular breed classes. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" and age division on the regular entry form under additional classes.

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The American Kennel Club will collect: a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee where applicable for the first entry of a dog, plus a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for The American Kennel Club. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to The American Kennel Club along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

- Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify BaRay Events at (360) 755-7086 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11, Section 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors setups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done at least 20 ft. away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
- All persons attending this event hereby waive any claim for damages against the Club, or its, members, in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions.
- All vehicles parked in VIP Parking Area without VIP Pass will be ticketed and fined.
- The American Whippet Club, may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
