While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disgualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class. Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class. NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner.
