BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

BEST FROM THE BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES BEST VETERAN FROM THE VETERANS CLASSES

AWARDS OF MERIT: Awards of Merit may be given at the judge's discretion to no more than two. The judge is not obligated to award any Award of Merit if he/she feels there are not any dogs or bitches in competition worthy of this award. The Award of Merit winners will be selected after the Best of Breed, Best of Oppsite Sex and Best of Winners awards are made. All dogs competing in the Best of of Breed competition are eligible for this award, with the exception of the Best of Breed winner. A Rosette will be given to the Award of Merit selections.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

STUD DOG. For Stud Dogs and at least two and not more than four of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH. For Bitches and at least two and no more than four of their produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class.

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The Dogs comprising a Brace MUST be entered in a Regular class, and named at the time of entry. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be designated "Brace No. 1," Brace No. 2," etc.

TEAM CLASS: Four dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The Dogs comprising a Team MUST be entered in a Regular class, and named at the time of entry. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Team MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Team Class." If more than one Team is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH TEAM must be designated "Team No. 1," Team No. 2," etc.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace or Team Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitchs making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

The Sweepstakes is open to all Chinese Shar-Pei who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes, indicating in the space for "Additional Classes" your entry in Sweepstakes. Anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club may show in Sweepstakes.

The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Chinese Shar-Pei who are at least 7 years of age on the day of the show.

ENTRY FEE: \$14.00 for each dog and bitch entered in Veteran Sweepstakes. Anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club may show in Veteran Sweepstakes.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS REGARDING CORRECTIONS OR CHANGES TO ENTRIES: Corrections other than the specific changes listed in Ch. 11, Sec. 6 (i.e. sex of a dog, transfers between age specific classes, and "move-up's" to BOB or BOV) are the only changes to the entries superintendents or secretaries are authorized to make after closing of entries. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. THIS RULE IS BEING STRICTLY ENFORCED BY THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB. PLEASE CHECK YOUR ENTRIES CAREFULLY. Corrections to entries may be made by the Superintendent prior to the closing of entries if such correction is submitted in writing. Exhibitors are required to report any changes/corrections after closing directly to the American Kennel Club.



ADDITIONAL RULES FOR HURRICANE RIDGE SHOWS/GROUNDS

- All Dogs shall be kept on leash except when in the Obedience or Rally ring.
- Grooming areas will be designated and grooming rules will be posted and strictly enforced.
 There will be no set-ups, generators, exercise pens or grooming within 30 feet of any rings.
 Crates will be allowed at ringside immediately prior to your breed judging, but must be removed immediately following breed judging.
- Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around grooming and/or parking areas.
- The Hurricane Ridge Kennel Club of Washington, Inc. will provide shade tents on the north and south sides of the Conformation Rings. These may be used by Exhibitors waiting to go into the ring. No chairs or grooming allowed.
- Exhibitors are asked to clean up after their own dogs, PLEASE. Designated exercise areas will be clearly marked.
- Exhibitors will be required to furnish their own cover and electricity.
- No parking is allowed on the streets around the show site. Violators will be towed. Entrance
 to the show grounds is from Blake Avenue ONLY.

- NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS -



The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The AKC will collect a \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee and 50 cent Recording Fee for the first entry of a dog in all
 AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. If a dog is entered in more than one
 class in the show, the Event/Recording Fees to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Ch.11, Sec. 2). In
 accordance with AKC Rally regulations, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 per entry of dog Rally Event Service Fee. A
 show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for AKC.
- CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNA-TIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish
 any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog
 holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned
 entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry
 Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or
 the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge
 or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered
 incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or
 OVERPAYMENTS. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been
 processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the
 management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Superintendent will add a \$20.00 collection
 fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may
 result in their being out on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
