NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS



The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these Shows and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

SHOW REGULATIONS

(Applicable To Both Days) ENTRY INFORMATION

Entries close at Superintendent's Office - 12:00 Noon, Wednesday, January 29, 2003. Fees must accompany entries. Canadian Exhibitors MUST make all checks and/or money orders payable in U.S. Funds. All checks and money orders to be made payable to BaRay Event Services, Inc. and mailed to P.O. Box 3075, Sequim, WA 98382.

ENTRIES MAY BE HAND-CARRIED or sent by Private Courier to 203 S. 4th Ave., Sequim, WA 98382

- AKC RECORDING FEE; A RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule. Chapter 14. Section 2).
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, E-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent entered a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season; bitches entered for breed competition are eligible to be shown. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is deemed impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made. Extreme weather conditions such as but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, typhoons, lightning, extreme heat, severe wind and rain must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs and exhibitors and spectators are of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry will be made.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change, overpayment of entries or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. There will be a processing charge.
- JUDGING No Dogs will be allowed in the show area except those regularly entered in the Show. DO NOT BRING ANY DOGS THAT ARE NOT ENTERED. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.
- The Club and its Superintendent will not be responsible and are not obligated, to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class; it is not the responsibility of the ring steward to locate any dog, its owner or its agent when the dog's presence is needed in the judging ring. Judges will NOT wait for any dog holding up a class.
- ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgement and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgement within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Superintedent at the above address or telephone (360) 683-1507.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. Animals left in vehicles will be monitored by County Control Officers and Club Members. If animals are in distress due to heat or any other circumstance, the vehicle will be forcibly entered, the animal recovered and the owner cited.
- FAX ENTRIES Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Offered for MasterCard, VISA or American Express cardholders ONLY. A \$4.00 charge will be added to each entry per show. Include cardholder's name, address, card number, expiration date, signature and 3-digit security code from back of Visa or MasterCard. If credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. Phone number (360) 683-6654. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). Credit card charges will show on your statement as Meeting Logistics Group.

- TROPHIES Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the dog, who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed, and the Show Chairman advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. No Award will be mailed.

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

It has been brought to our attention that some exhibitors have abused hotel rooms in the past and consequently many hotels have refused to accommodate guests and dogs. This is not a problem unique to the ORCHID ISLAND DOG FANCIER CLUB. but apparently a national problem. It is certainly to our benefit as owners, breeders and exhibitors to leave behind a positive feeling with the hotels and their management. Accordingly, the following rules have been established.

- PLASTIC SHEETING MUST BE PLACED UNDER ALL CRATES IN HOTEL ROOMS IN ORDER TO PROTECT THE CARPETS. PLASTIC SHEETS ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE HOST CLUBS, AT NO CHARGE, AT ALL TIMES.
- 2. DOGS MUST NOT BE LEFT ALONE AND UNATTENDED IN HOTEL ROOMS.
- 3. DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEAD AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN HOTEL HALLWAYS, LOBBIES, OR ON THE HOTEL GROUNDS. ROOMS AND HOTEL GROUNDS MUST BE KEPT FREE OF DOG DEBRIS.
- 4. DOGS SHOULD BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. EVERY OWNER/EXHIBITOR IS EXPECTED TO PICK UP AFTER HIS OWN DOGS (PLASTIC BAGS WILL BE AVAILABLE FROM THE HOST CLUB FOR THIS PURPOSE) AND DISPOSE OF THE WASTE IN NEARBY TRASH CANS.
- 5. NO DOG SHOULD BE BATHED IN THE HOTEL.
- 6. AS ROOMS WILL BE CLEANED DAILY BY THE HOTEL STAFF, ANY DAMAGE REPORTED TO THE HOTEL MANAGE-MENT WILL BE REPORTED TO THE SHOW COMMITTEE.
- 7. NO DOGS MAY BE GROOMED IN THE STADIUM BATHROOMS AT SHOW GROUNDS.

Because of this, any owner/exhibitor will be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the American Kennel Club, in addition to being held financially responsible for any damage to hotel property. We have provided above listed supplies at the front desk. Please feel free to ask for them. Thank you for taking the time to read this lengthy statements. NOVICE CLASS: For Boys and girls who are at least 10 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places in a Novice Class, with competition, at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 10 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class, with competition, at a licensed or member show.

For more information on eligibility requirements for Junior Showmanship and dog handled in Jr. Showmanship, write to the American Kennel Club, Show Plans, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606-3390. Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

USE OF RAMPS

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Petit Bassets Griffons Vendeens, Whippets, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Bulldogs. Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)
