All of those Specialty Clubs that have reserved space(s) in the first row only of RV parking, will be allowed to reserve the space directly in front of their parking space(s) for grooming, or other usage. The width of the reserved area will not exceed the width of the parking space(s) and will only extend 10 feet directly in front of the parking space(s). From I-405 - Take Exit #14 for Hwy 520 East to Redmond. Go east on 520 for approx. 5 miles to the W. Lake Sammamish Parkway exit. Take the right of the 2 lanes on the exit ramp and turn right at traffic light onto W. Lk. Sammamish Pkwy. Immediately move to the left turn lane and turn left at the traffic light into Marymoor Park, Follow the main road and look for Show/Parking signs.

If at the end of the 90 day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC."
