

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The AKC will collect a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on each entry of a dog, and 50 cent Recording Fee for the first
 entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. If a dog is entered
 in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Ch.11, Sec.
 2). In accordance with AKC Rally regulations, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 per entry of dog Rally Event Service Fee.
 A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for AKC.
- CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNA-TIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned
 entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry
 Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or
 the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Superintendent will add a \$20.00 collection
 fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may
 result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- FAX ENTRIES Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card

 show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11,

- ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Superintendent at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. USE OF RAMPS

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp: Basset Hounds, Whippets. Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes classes will be held for each breed, and are open to all hounds. Dogs must be entered in the regular classes of the Western Washington Hound Association show held the same day. No dog may be handled by a Professional Handler unless handler is the registered owner of the dog. No Puppy shall be entered whose age will be less than 6 months or greater than 18 months on the day of the show. Sweepstakes will exclude Champions.
