BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

Non-Regular Classes (involving multiple dog entries)

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its Breed. Get must be entered in a regular class. Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: For Brood Bitches and two of their produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its Breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class.

BRACE CLASS: For two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be designated "Brace No.1," "Brace No.2"

OBEDIENCE TRIAL CLASSES

Qualifying score is required for all prizes in the regular classes.

There shall be a refund of all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches, entered in obedience, who come in season after the closing date of the obedience trial. To be eligible for the refund, a certificate from a veterinarian must be presented to the obedience chair before judging begins.
