The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The AKC will collect a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on each entry of a dog, and 50 cent Recording Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Ch.11, Sec. 2). In accordance with AKC Rally regulations, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 per entry of dog Rally Event Service Fee. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for AKC.
- CANADIÁN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNA-TIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned
 entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry
 Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club, Show Secretary and/or

- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge
 or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered
 incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or
 OVERPAYMENTS. BaRay Events will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed,

HUNTING RETRIEVER DOGS HUNTING RETRIEVER BITCHES

A Class for Dogs and a class for Bitches that have a Working Certificate (WC), Working Certificate Intermediate (WCI) or Working Certificate Excellent (WCX) from the NSDTRC (USA) or an AKC Junior Hunter title (JH), Senior Hunter title (SH) or Master Hunter title (MH).

Winners of the above non-regular classes, if otherwise undefeated,

will compete for Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. **BEST PUPPY FROM THE REGULAR PUPPY CLASSES:** To be selected from the first place winners in the Puppy Classes (6-9 mos. & 9-12 mos.)

BEST VETERAN FROM THE VETERANS CLASSES: To be selected from the first place winners of all the Veteran Classes.

JUDGE'S AWARD OF MERIT: The Judge may select up to 4 Tollers of the superior quality specimens in addition to Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex from the intersex competition.

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR COMPETITION: To be selected from the first place winners of the Bred-By-Exhibitor Classes.

BEST HUNTING RETRIEVER COMPETITION: To be selected from the first place winners of all the Hunting Retriever Classes.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple Dog Entries)

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed, or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed, or some other non-regular class.

BRACE CLASS: For two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be designated "Brace No.1," "Brace No.2"

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Entries must be accompanied by a cover sheet stating the number of pages, what shows and how many dogs per show. Visa, MasterCard, and American Express are accepted for Fax entries. Credit card information (Credit Card number, expiration date, and cardholder name) must be on cover sheet. Note: Visa and MasterCard users – You must include the 3-digit security code that appears above your signature on the back of the card. SWEEPSTAKES

A Sweepstakes will be held in conjunction with this Specialty. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. All dogs and bitches entered in Sweepstakes MUST ALSO be entered in a Regular Class at this Specialty, at the regular entry fee. The Sweepstakes is open to all dogs/bitches who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Champions of Record at the time that entries close are not eligible for the Sweepstakes. Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes, indicating in the space for "Additional Classes" your entry in Sweepstakes. HANDLER: The handler of a Sweepstakes exhibit must be either the owner, co-owner, breeder or a member of their immediate family as defined by the AKC as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Dogs and bitches entered in Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in a Regular Class at this Specialty. The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs/ bitches who are at least 7 years of age on the day of the show. Entrants need not be intact. Spayed or Neutered animals are eligible. Entries must be made on the same entry form, indicating your entry in Veteran Sweepstakes.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION

Classes are divided by age and sex as follows: Dogs (7 yrs. & under 10 yrs.) Dogs (10 yrs. & Older) DISTRIBUTION OF VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

35% to be retained by Club for expenses. NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 816-3776. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

- **Best Puppy Perpetual Trophy:** This is a bronze sculpture of a retriever playing in the water. Sagewood Kennel Best Puppy in Specialty Show Trophy offered by Patty and Paul Beran through the Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Club (USA). This trophy is offered on a threetime win basis, with permanent possession of the trophy going to any person/owner who wins the trophy three separate times, not necessarily with the same dog.
- Best Veteran Perpetual Trophy: This is an etched crystal of a toller coming out of the water with a duck. Hoch Memorial Trophy offered by Dee Nichols (KD's Kennel) and Laura White (Cinnstar Kennels) in memory of Robert Hoch through the NSDTRC (USA). This trophy is offered on a three-time win basis, with permanent possession of the trophy going to any person/owner who wins the trophy three separate times, not necessarily with the same dog
- High in Trial Perpetual Trophy: A silver cup trophy on a base. Lonetree Kennel High in Trial Trophy offered by Lonetree Kennels through the NSDTRC (USA). This trophy is offered on a three-time win basis, with permanent possession of the trophy going to any person/owner who wins the trophy three times, not necessarily with the same dog.
