The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owners' records.

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud Dogs MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require it disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches MUST be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitches are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitches must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require it disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If both dogs are entered in another class at the show, entry fee for Brace Class as a UNIT is \$25.00. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars MUST be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes. "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be so designated – "Brace No. 1," Brace No. 2," etc.
