

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The AKC will collect a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on each entry of a dog, and 50 cent Recording Fee for the first entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Ch. 11, Sec. 2). In accordance with AKC Rally regulations, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 per entry of dog Rally Event Service Fee. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for AKC.
- CANADIAN CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS MUST BE DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS, AND/OR MADE PAYABLE IN U.S. FUNDS
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned
 entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry
 Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or
 the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Superintendent will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- FAX ENTRIES Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. FAX NUMBER: (360) 683-6654. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). - ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Superintendent at (360) 683-1507 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish
 any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog
 holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

*The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13). Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Single Dog Entries)

VETERAN DOGS VETERAN BITCHES

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches seven years of age and older HERDING TITLE DOG CLASS HERDING TITLE BITCH CLASS

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches that have achieved an AKC Herding Trial title as listed in the current AKC Herding Trial Manual (HT, PT, HI, HX, or HC). Dogs and Bitches entered in a Herding Title class must be intact.

Winners of these Non-Regular classes, if otherwise undefeated, will compete for Best of Breed. BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship so a Championship according to the owners' records.

AWARD OF MERIT: Awards of Merit may be given at the judges discretion to no more than five (5) exhibits of the Best of Breed Class at it's conclusion, with the exception of Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries)

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dog and Two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in

the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: Same as above, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog, and substitute Produce for Get.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

RULES FOR THE SILVERDALE BEACH HOTEL

- 1. Dogs must be crated in guest rooms at all times, especially when owners are not in the room. NO EXCEPTIONS! Plastic is required under all crates. This is to be provided by the dogs owner. You are responsible for any damages. No ex-pen setup allowed in the rooms.
- There will be a \$25.00 non-refundable deposit required, per owner, per room. Each room will be inspected prior to checkout and if extra cleaning is needed or damage has been done, the cost will be incurred by the guest. All bedspreads will be removed from rooms prior to check in.
- 3. NO dogs are to be bathed or groomed in the rooms at any time.
- 4. Dogs must be leashed, crated or penned at all times outside your room, except when showing in obedience.
- 5. There is a maximum of 4 dogs per room.
- 6. Dogs must be cleaned up after. Please contact the hotel's front desk if you need to clean up inside the hotel or your room. Minimal clean up supplies will be furnished to you by the hotel. You will be responsible for any additional cleaning and/or supplies. Hotel and Hotel Liaison representative shall be notified and shall inspect room after cleanup.
- 7. No dogs are permitted in restrooms, restaurant or pool areas. Observe and Obey Signs some areas of the hotel are off limits to dogs. Please respect posted signs and staff directions regarding designated areas.
- 8. The grooming area will be on the blacktop area located east of the building.
- 9. The hotel will provide a water source near the designated bathing area. Cascade will provide a bathing tub.
- Tents (canopies) for shade or foul weather may be setup on grass or hard surfaces as needed. No permanent tie down stakes/holes shall be placed in paved or concrete surfaces. Only weights or sand bags shall be used for these surfaces.
- 11. Outdoor exercise areas must be picked up by owners after use by their dogs. Scoopers or (Preferably) plastic baggies need to be deposited in designated trash cans only.
- 12. No dog "marking" is permitted.
