

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must
KENNEL CLUB\* make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on
the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008, The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. The current 50 cent recording fee will continue to be collected where applicable. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for The American Kennel Club. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to The American Kennel Club along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.
- CANADIAN CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS MUST BE DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS, AND/OR MADE PAYABLE IN U.S. FUNDS
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned
  entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies
  of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray
  Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner
  or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$20.00 collection
  fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent
  may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.

- ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program
  to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE

- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by
  the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has
  been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. BaRay Events
  will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
  If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible

# Non-Regular Classes (Involving Single Dog Entries)

Veteran Dogs Veteran Bitches

A class for dogs and a class for bitches, 6 years of age and older. Entrants in Veterans need not be intact, spayed and neutered animals are eligible. Winners of the Veterans Classes, if otherwise undefeated at this show, compete for Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records.

Best Puppy from the Regular Puppy Classes • Best from the Bred by Exhibior classes

# Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

STUD DOG. For Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class. Entry fee is \$20.00 for the Unit.

**BROOD BITCH**. For Bitches and two of their produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class. Entry fee is \$20.00 for the Unit.

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The Dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. Entry fee for Brace Class as a UNIT is \$20.00. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars MUST be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be designated "Brace No. 1," Brace No. 2," etc.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitchs making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.
