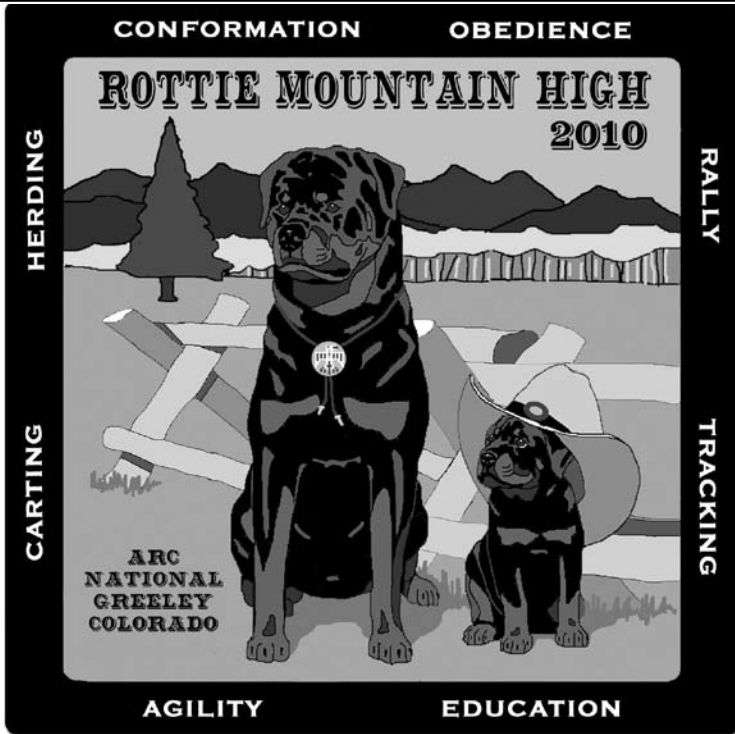

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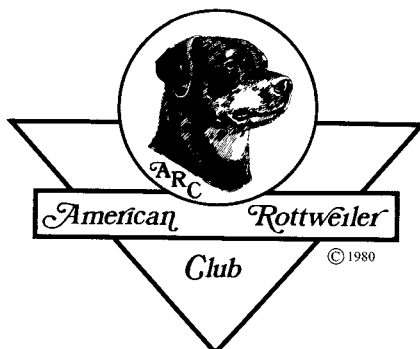

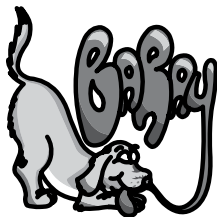

Dogs must be removed from the show site crating area (Exposition Building) at conclusion of evening events (9:00 p.m.). Dogs may not stay in building overnight. All tables, empty crates, etc. must be removed by Sunday April 25, 2010. 10x10 grooming spots are available for entire week @ \$25 each.

Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their Dogs under control at all times and **MUST** clean up after them in any area of the Island Grove Regional Park or the hotels/motels where the Exhibitor is staying. Failure to do so could result in disciplinary action. Remember that dogs must be on leash at all times unless in performance or conformation rings. There will be a designated area for bathing of dogs and it will be posted. Please remember all complaints by hotel/motel management or Island Grove Regional Park personnel may result in an Event Committee Hearing

JUNIOR HANDLERS who win a third Novice Class after closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from Novice Class to Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least 1/2 hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging or one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

**STUD DOG CLASS:** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its Breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class. An entry fee of \$30.00 will be charged for the Stud Dog if he is NOT entered in one of the Regular Classes, Non-Regular Classes or for Best of Breed Competition. Entry fee for Stud Dog as an additional class is \$25.00.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS:** For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Same rules as Stud Dog.

**BRACE CLASS:** For two Rottweilers that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. Dogs need not be entered in another class. Entry fee for Brace as a Unit is \$25.00. If either dog is not entered in another class, the fee for the Unit is \$30.00.

*NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, not one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.*

THE FUTURITY STAKE IS OPEN TO ROTTWEILER BREEDERS IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB. ALSO, THE FUTURITY IS OPEN ONLY TO LITTERS FROM PARENTS WHO WERE TWO YEARS OF AGE AND OFA HIP CERTIFIED PRIOR TO THE DATE THE BREEDING TOOK PLACE.

Any breeder who, having nominated a litter, fails to remain in good standing with the AKC and has not been reinstated 30 days prior to the Futurity shall lose all rights in the ARC Futurity.

The Futurity Stake is entered by nominating the litter. The get from this litter are eligible to compete in the first annual Futurity Stake held on or after the date they reach six months of age, and only in this stake.

The Rottweiler MUST be entered in one of the regular classes at the ARC National Specialty show. When completing the entry form for the ARC Specialty, the fact that the Rottweiler is to be shown in the Futurity MUST BE INDICATED AS AN EXTRA CLASS in the appropriate space provided on the entry form. No additional fee will be required for the futurity class. No Rottweiler will be eligible to compete in the Futurity, which does not meet the following requirements:

1. Be from a litter that was properly and timely nominated.
2. Have been individually nominated before it has reached the age of four months
3. Be properly entered in one of the regular classes of the ARC Specialty.
4. Whelped from parents who are two years of age and OFA Hip certified prior to the date that the breeding took place.

### **FUTURITY STAKE CLASSES**

\*The dates of the ARC National Specialty fluctuate from year to year. Puppies are eligible to compete in the first ARC National Futurity held on or after the date they reach six months of age, and only in this Futurity. ### **FUTURITY PRIZES**

In this stake there will be 35 cash wins, the three individuals (the breeder, the owner, and the owner of the sire at the time of nomination) partaking of these awards, for a total of 72 monetary awards, won by 32 different Rottweilers.

Ten Percent shall be deducted from the total nomination and entry fee purse to be used for Futurity expenses. This will be known as the General Expense Fund. This Fund shall be used to cover all expenses incurred by the Futurity Stake, i.e., judges, printing, mailing, etc. Since the administrative and judging expense will vary from year to year, excess in any given year shall be carried for use in future years.

Twenty-five percent shall be deducted from the total nomination and entry fee purse to be awarded as follows: 15% to the Best in Futurity, 5% to the Best Senior in Futurity, and 5% to the Best Junior in Futurity. The 15% Best in Futurity award will be divided: 50% to the recorded breeder of the winner and 50% to the recorded owner of the winner. The 5% awarded to the Best Junior and Best Senior in Futurity is to be divided: 50% to the recorded breeder, 30% to the recorded owner and 20% to the owner of the sire or owner of the frozen semen at the time of mating, for each winner.

The remaining 65 percent of the total purse shall be divided according to the percent of the total entry represented by the number of dogs entered in each class.

Monetary Awards will be given to the handler presenting the puppy in the ring for the four class placements. The Best Junior, Best Senior and Best in Futurity monetary awards will be given to the breeder who nominated the litter, the sire's owner who is listed first on the litter nomination and the puppy owner who is listed first on the individual puppy nomination. The monetary award will be mailed to them should they not be present. Monetary awards, which are provided for but cannot be given, whatever the reason, shall be applied to the total Futurity Stake for the following year.

The Best in Futurity Trophy will be given to the breeder who has nominated the litter. Should the winner not be present the trophy will be mailed.
