The ARC 2004 National Specialty Show Site is the host hotel, except for Agility, Tracking, and Herding (please see appropriate sections regarding these events). Set up will begin on Monday, March 29, 2004. There will be a tented area outside the building where the conformation ring is for crating which will be available to Exhibitors beginning Tuesday, March 30, 2004 for crate drop off. You must reserve your crating space by March 15, 2004. The cost is \$20 for all days. See form in premium list. There is to be no crating or xpens on showsite except in designated areas. There will be temporary crating space available for the obedience events.

Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their Dogs under control at all times & MUST clean up after their dogs in any area of the Show Site (Kings Island Resort & Conference Center). Remember that dogs need to be on leash at all times. Dogs are strictly prohibited from being in any restroom or shower area. THE FUTURITY STAKE IS OPEN TO ROTTWEILER BREEDERS IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB. ALSO, THE FUTURITY IS OPEN ONLY TO LITTERS FROM PARENTS WHO WERE TWO YEARS OF AGE AND OFA HIP CERTIFIED PRIOR TO THE DATE THE BREEDING TOOK PLACE.

Any breeder who, having nominated a litter, fails to remain in good standing with the AKC and has not been reinstated 30 days prior to the Futurity shall lose all rights in the ARC Futurity.

The Futurity Stake is entered by nominating the litter. The get from this litter are eligible to compete in the first annual Futurity Stake held on or after the date they reach six months of age, and only in this stake.

*Due to the fluctuation of the ARC National Specialty date, there will be times when puppies older that 18 months will be entered because they were NOT 6 months old when the prior Futurity Stake was held. This year, because it is the first time that a Futurity is being offered, dogs born between March 25, 2002 and September 30, 2002 will be eligible to enter the + 18 class.

Twenty-five percent shall be deducted from the total nomination and entry fee purse to be awarded as follows: 15% to the Best in Futurity, 5% to the Best Senior in Futurity, and 5% to the Best Junior in Futurity. The 15% Best in Futurity award will be divided: 50% to the recorded breeder of the winner and 50% to the recorded owner of the winner.. The 5% awarded to the Best Junior and Best Senior in Futurity is to be divided: 50% to the recorded breeder, 30% to the recorded owner and 20% to the owner of the sire or owner of the frozen semen at the time of mating, for each winner.

The remaining 65 percent of the total purse shall be divided according to the percent of the total entry represented by the number of dogs entered in each class.

Monetary Awards will be given to the handler presenting the puppy in the ring for the four class placements. The Best Junior, Best Senior and Best in Futurity monetary awards will be given to the breeder who nominated the litter, the sire's owner who is listed first on the litter nomination and the puppy owner who is listed first on the individual puppy nomination. The monetary award will be mailed to them should they not be present.
