Because WINNERS of these classes will compete for Best of Breed, all entrants MUST also meet ALL American Kennel Club requirements for Non-Regular Classes involving single dog entries. NOTE: Any placement other than First in any of these classes eliminates the dog from competing in Best of Breed Competition.

*Veteran Dogs, 8 Yrs. & under 10 Yrs.

*Veteran Bitches, 8 Yrs. & under 10 Yrs.

*Veteran Bitches, 10 Yrs. & Older

*Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class.

Best of Breed Competition – The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records.

Grand Champion Competition – The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition: 1. Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Best of Variety class. 2. Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. 3. Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition. (Altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible.) 4. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition. At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to: 1. Best of Breed or Variety 2. Best of Opposite 3. Select Dog 4. Select Bitch. Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed sest of Variety competition.

Award of Merit – At the conclusion of Best of Breed, after picking Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch, the Specialty Judge at his/her discretion may award Rosettes for Awards of Merit to a maximum of 10% of the Best of Breed entry.

Best Puppy from the Regular Puppy Classes - After Best of Breed, the first place winner of each of the four puppy classes will compete for Best Puppy. The 12 months and under 18 months classes are not considered a puppy class.

Best Veteran – After Best of Breed, the first place winner of each of the four veteran classes will compete for Best Veteran.



OPEN CLASS: For Boys and Girls who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE & OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 816-3776. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form. By signing the entry form certification is given that the Junior Showman does not now, and will not at any time, act as an agent/handler for pay while continuing to compete in Junior Showmanship. Each dog entered must be of the breed for which this show is held. NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Only fee applies.

SWEEPSTAKES AND VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

HANDLER: The handler of any sweepstakes exhibit must be either the owner, co-owner, breeder or member of their immediate family as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date for the show for which the sweepstakes entry is being made. Immediate family is defined as husband, wife, mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter or legal domestic partner. Step children and legal wards are also included in this definition. In-laws and grandchildren are not considered to be immediate family members. No other individual may take the entry into the ring during judging or check-in.

The following individuals are excluded from showing an exhibit in sweepstakes unless they are the sole owner registered with the AKC or co-own the entry with a member of their immediate family (as defined above) or a legal domestic partner:

- Any individual listed as an Agent on any dog in any regular or non-regular class at this or any other show in the previous two years.
- Any individual with an Agent number including, but not limited to, an AKC Registered Handler Number or Professional Handlers Association (PHA) number.

To avoid confusion or question, it is recommended that a photocopy of the registration certificate be included with the entry for a co-owned exhibit.

Disabled or physically challenged handlers are encouraged to show their own dogs and every effort will be made to accommodate them.

Best in Sweepstakes Classes: It is required that the same person who showed the dog to a first place in a sweepstakes class will also show the dog in the Best in Sweepstakes class. However, if that person should have more than one dog in the Best in Sweepstakes class, someone else is permitted to show the additional winner. That person should meet the handler definitions above. Only in cases where there is not another owner, co-owner, breeder, co-breeder or immediate family member available, should another person take the dog into the Best in Sweepstakes class. It is understood that there would be no financial benefit to that individual. Individuals who have an AKC Handler number, a PHA number or are listed as Agent on any dog in the regular or non-regular classes may not show a sweepstakes entrant unless they are the sole owner registered with the AKC or co-own the entry with a member of their immediate family (as defined above) or a legal domestic partner.

ENTRIES: Entry Fee is \$23.00. Entries must be made at the same time and on the same official AKC entry form as the regular classes, indicating in the space titled "Additional Classes" the Sweepstakes entry and age division.

SWEEPSTAKES

ELIGIBILITY: Any purebred Golden Retriever six months of age and under eighteen months of age and entered in any of the regular classes at the specialty show at which the Sweepstakes are held. Dogs which have completed the requirements for an AKC Championship (according to AKC records) prior to the closing date of the show at which the Sweepstakes are to be held are not eligible.

CLASS DIVISIONS: Class divisions shall be the same for dogs and bitches.

6 months and under 9 months • 9 months and under 12 months

12 months and under 15 months • 15 months and under 18 months

After the completion of the individual class judging, each of the eight class winners shall be brought back to the ring for the selection of Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

ELIGIBILITY: Any purebred Golden Retriever over eight years of age which is individually registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). Entrants need not be entered in any other class. AKC and CKC Champions of Record and spayed or neutered Golden Retrievers are eligible.

CLASS DIVISIONS: Class divisions shall be the same for dogs and bitches.

8 years and under 10 years • 10 years and under 12 years • 12 years and over

After the completion of the individual class judging, each of the six class winners shall be brought back to the ring for the awarding of Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes.

ADDITIONAL GROUNDS AND PARKING RULES

- · Fire Lanes must be kept clear.
- Generators must be turned off at 10:00 PM and not turned on until 6:00 AM.
- No gray water or sewage is to be dumped on the grounds.
- Generators must exhaust away from dogs, people and RVs.
- Animals left in vehicles will be monitored. If animals are in distress due to heat or any other circumstance, the vehicle will be forcibly entered, the animal recovered and the owner cited. The Club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the vehicle involved.
