The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- Effective for events held on and after January 1, 2004, the AKC will collect a \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee for the first entry
 of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. The current 50 cent recording fee
 will continue to be collected. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event
 Service Fees for the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Event/Recording Fees to be collected
 on the first entry only. (AKC Rule. Chapter 11, Section 2).
- CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL Money orders in U.S. Funds
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service
 for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners
 or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be
 accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement
 and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong
 or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS
 OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. The Superintendent will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Superintendent will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the
