BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Grand Champion Selects

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owners' records.

GRAND CHAMPION COMPETITION – The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition: 1. Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Best of Variety class. 2. Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. 3. Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition. (Altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible.) 4. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition. At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to: 1. Best of Breed or Variety 2. Best of Opposite 3. Select Dog 4. Select Bitch. Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed competition and in breeds that are divided into varieties, Grand Champion Competition will not continue beyond Best of Variety competition.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Single Dog Entries)

Coursing Dog Class Coursing Bitch Class

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches who are AKC registered and are confirmed Field Champions, Coursing Champions or Coursers of Merit.

Exhibitors must supply proof of eligibility for this class with the entry. (A copy of the certificate awarding the title or a copy of the ENTIRE PAGE from either the AKC Gazette or Field Advisory News magazine publishing the title will be accepted as proof). Dogs/Bitches will not be entered into this class without proof of title accompanying the entry form. First place winners in this class are eligible for Best of Breed Competition providing all AKC eligibility requirements have been met. NOTE: No Championship Points are awarded for this class. Any dog/bitch defeated in this or any other regular or non-regular class, except sweepstakes, is not eligible for the Best of Breed Competition.

Veteran Dogs 1 & Veteran Bitches 1 – Class for Dogs & Class for Bitches 7 years & under 10 years.
Veteran Dogs 2 Veteran Bitches 2 – Class for Dogs and Class for Bitches 10 years & under 12 years.
Veteran Dogs 3 – Veteran Bitches 3 – Class for Dogs and Class for Bitches 12 years of age and older.
Winners of the Veterans Classes may also compete for Best of Breed Competition, provided that they are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show. Spayed and neutered animals may be entered and shown in Veteran Classes at specialty shows.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries)

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dog and at least two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification

or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class. An entry fee of \$27.00 will be charged as a first entry, (Stud Dog and at least two of its get) \$20.00 as a second entry for the Stud Dog. Get must be entered in one of the regular classes.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: For Brood Bitch and at least two of their Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class. An entry fee of \$27.00 will be charged as a first entry, (Brood Bitch and at least two of its produce) \$20.00 as a second entry for the Brood Bitch. Produce must be entered in one of the regular classes.

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The Dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at the time of entry. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars **MUST** be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If a dog, which is to be part of a Brace, is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for Best of Breed Competition, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." Brace is a single entry (unit) and includes both dogs. Fee is \$20.00.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, or Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

JUDGE'S AWARD OF MERIT

At the conclusion of the regular Best of Breed judging, the judge may at his/her discretion, may grant an Award of Merit (AOM). The judge is not obligated to grant an AOM, if he/she feels there are not any dogs or bitches in competition worthy of this award. The total number of AOMs the judge is allowed to award is dictated by the total number of dogs and bitches competing in the Best of Breed competition, which shall be one AOM for each seven entered. A Rosette is offered for this award.

To stimulate interest in the showing of young and older Salukis, a Puppy Sweepstakes and a Veteran Sweepstakes will be held in conjunction with the Puget Sound Saluki Club Specialty Shows. Classes will NOT be divided by coat (i.e., Smooth or Feathered).

General Rules – Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes. Indicate “Sweepstakes” or “Veteran Sweepstakes” (stating AGE/CLASS) in the space for “Additional Classes.” Dogs need not be owner-handled, but handlers who usually charge a fee for their services will not be allowed in the ring unless they own the dog being handled. This includes employees and immediate family members. Entry fee is \$20.00 for each dog/bitch entered in the Sweepstakes, in addition to any regular entry fee.

Distribution of Funds – Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes Sweepstakes and Veteran Sweepstakes are separate entities and prize money will be distributed according to the entry in each Sweepstakes. 35% of Total Entry Fee will be retained by the Puget Sound Saluki Club for expenses. Winners of each class will compete for the remaining 65%. Monies will be disbursed among 1st place winners of each class.

The current 50 cent recording fee will continue to be collected where applicable. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for The American Kennel Club. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to The American Kennel Club along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.
- **CANADIAN CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS MUST BE DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS, AND/OR MADE PAYABLE IN U.S. FUNDS**
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.
