

BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR (BBE) CLASS ELIGIBILITY: 1. All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC. 2. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. 3. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Dogs Veteran Bitches A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches, 7 years of age and older. Dogs/bitches entered in Veterans need not be intact. Working Dogs Working Bitches

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches with working/performance titles. The Dog/Bitch must have earned one or more of the following AKC titles: CD; RN; TD; HS; NA; NAJ; NAP; NJP; NF; NFP; or an American Rottweiler Club CS. A Dog/Bitch is also eligible if it has earned one of the following titles: SchH A; SchH I; IPO I; VPG I; FH; BH; AD. Copy of title and/or Scorebook must be included with entry. Spayed and Neutered animals are ineligible to be entered in this class. Champions of Record are eligible to enter.

Winners of the above Non-Regular Single Dog classes, if otherwise undefeated,

are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION – The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. Selects, if applicable, will be chosen following Best of Breed.

CRC JUDGE'S AWARD – At the Judge's discretion, CRC Judge's Awards will be awarded to a maximum of 10% of the Best of Breed Entry, including Winners Dog and Winners Bitch and Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch, with no limitations as to the sex. The 10% is in **addition** to the two CRC Judge's Awards automatically awarded to the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex Winners.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judges decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of having won any of these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dogs and two their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Get

must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular class. BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as above except substitute Brood Bitch For Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

- **NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- **OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 816-3776. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

The letters GO may be added after the name of each dog that has been certified by three different judges to have received qualifying scores in Graduate Open classes at three licensed or member obedience trials.

Versatility Class – The Versatility class will be for all dogs and is an optional titling class that may be offered by clubs at obedience events. The letters VER may be added after the name of each dog that has been certified by three different judges to have received qualifying scores in Versatility classes at three licensed or member obedience trials.

Veterans Class – The Veterans class will be for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least 7 years old on the date of the trial. The exercises will be performed and judged as in the Novice class.

Brace Class – The Brace class will be for two Rottweilers that are eligible under these regulations and capable of performing the Novice exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person but will be handled by one handler. Dogs may be entered for Brace Competition Only. The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry.

These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to The AKC along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH FNTRANT

Spayed and Neutered animals are ineligible to be entered in this class. Champions of Record are eligible to enter.

Winners of the above Non-Regular Single Dog classes, if otherwise undefeated,

are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

BEST PUPPY FROM THE REGULAR PUPPY CLASSES AND BEST FROM THE BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASES: Winners of Best Puppy or Best Bred by Exhibitor are not, by right of winning this award, eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records. Select Dog and Select Bitch will be awarded following Best of Breed.

ARC SELECT AWARDS: All dogs eligible for the Best of Breed Competition shall be considered for these awards. At the discretion of the intersex judge, the maximum number of Select Awards that may be given shall be 10% of the Best of Breed entry, including Veterans, Winners and Working Dog/Bitch. That 10%, with no consideration to sex, is in addition to the ones automatically given Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed winners and the AKC Grand Championship Select Dog and Bitch (if awarded). As the judges decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of having won any of these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dogs and two their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. THE FUTURITY STAKE IS OPEN TO ROTTWEILER BREEDERS IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE AMERI-CAN KENNEL CLUB. ALSO, THE FUTURITY IS OPEN ONLY TO LITTERS FROM PARENTS WHO WERE TWO YEARS OF AGE AND OFA HIP CERTIFIED PRIOR TO THE DATE THE BREEDING TOOK PLACE.

Any breeder who, having nominated a litter, fails to remain in good standing with the AKC and has not been reinstated 30 days prior to the Futurity shall lose all rights in the ARC Futurity. The Futurity Stake is entered by nominating the litter. The get from this litter are eligible to compete in the first annual Futurity Stake held on or after the date they reach six months of age, and only in this stake. The Futurity is open to all Rottweilers who were born between 10/22/09 and 11/11/10, provided both the litter and individual puppy have been properly and timely nominated. *The dates of the ARC National Specialty fluctuate from year to year, so there will be times when puppies older that 18 months will be entered because they were NOT 6 months old when the prior year's Futurity was held. The 2010 Futurity was held on April 21st, so dogs born between 10/22/09 and 11/11/09 are eligible to compete even though they are older than 18 months of age.

The Rottweiler MUST be entered in one of the regular classes at the ARC National Specialty show. When completing the entry form for the ARC Specialty, the fact that the Rottweiler is to be shown in the Futurity MUST BE INDICATED AS AN EXTRA CLASS in the appropriate space provided on the entry form. No additional fee will be required for the futurity class.

No Rottweiler will be eligible to compete in the Futurity which does not meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be from a litter that was properly and timely nominated.
- 2. Have been individually nominated before it has reached the age of four months

- 3. Be properly entered in one of the regular classes of the ARC Specialty.
- 4. Whelped from parents who are two years of age and OFA Hip certified prior to the date that the breeding took place.

FUTURITY PRIZES

In this stake there will be 43 cash wins, the three individuals (the breeder, the owner, and the owner of the sire at the time of nomination) partaking of these awards, for a total of 88 monetary awards, won by 40 different Rottweilers.

Twenty percent shall be deducted from the total nomination fee purse to be used for Futurity expenses. This will be known as the General Expense Fund. This Fund shall be used to cover all expenses incurred by the Futurity, i.e., judges, rosettes, Chair expenses, etc. Since the administrative and judging expense will vary from year to year, excess in any given year shall be carried for use in future years.

Twenty percent shall be deducted from the total nomination and entry fee purse to be awarded as follows: 10% to the Best in Futurity, 5% to the Best Senior in Futurity, and 5% to the Best Junior in Futurity. The 10% Best in Futurity award will be divided: 50% to the recorded breeder of the winner and 50% to the recorded owner of the winner. The 5% awarded to the Best Junior and Best Senior in Futurity is to be divided: 50% to the recorded breeder, 30% to the recorded owner and 20% to the owner of the sire or owner of the frozen semen at the time of mating, for each winner.

The remaining 60 percent of the total nomination fee purse shall be divided by the total number of puppies entered to get a "per puppy amount". This amount would be multiplied by the number of puppies in each class to get the total amount of prize money for that class and then each class shall be divided as follows: 1st place: 40%*; 2nd place: 30%*; 3rd place: 20%*; 4th place: 10%*. *The prize money for each placement shall be further divided with the 60% to the recorded breeder; 40% to the recorded owner.

Monetary Awards will be given to the handler presenting the puppy in the ring for the four class placements. The Best Junior, Best Senior and Best in Futurity monetary awards will be given to the breeder who nominated the litter, the sire's owner who is listed first on the litter nomination and the puppy owner who is listed first on the individual puppy nomination. The monetary award will be mailed to them should they not be present.

Monetary awards, which are provided for but cannot be given, whatever the reason, shall be sent to the ARC Treasurer and incorporated into the ARC General Fund.

The Best in Futurity Trophy will be given to the breeder who has nominated the litter. Should the winner not be present the trophy will be mailed.
