BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

USE OF RAMPS

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Whippets, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Bulldogs & Chow Chows. Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

Bullmastiffs: Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brindle; Any Other Allowed Color.

Doberman Pinschers: Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Black; Any Other Allowed Color.

Great Danes: Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Brindle, Fawn, Blue, Black, Harlequin, Mantle.

St. Bernards: Open Classes Divided, Both Sexes: Longhaired; Shorthaired.

RALLY NOVICE & RALLY ADVANCED

The purpose of the Rally Style Obedience concept is to create an obedience program that emphasizes fun and excitement for the dog, the handler, and spectators, by providing a more "natural" approach to the performance. The ability to work as a team in this way during a Rally Style Obedience performance portrays a more natural working situation that greatly adds to the handler's ability to maintain the dog's attention and attitude at a high level. In Rally classes, the team of dog and handler move continuously and perform the exercises indicated by a sign at each location. After the Judge's "Forward" command, the team is on its own to complete the entire sequence correctly. Unlimited communication from the handler to the dog between signs is to be encouraged and not penalized.

What is permitted: Handlers are permitted to talk, praise, encourage, clap their hands, pat their legs, or any verbal means of encouragement.

What is not permitted: Handlers may not touch their dog or make corrections with the leash.

RALLY NOVICE CLASS. All exercises are performed on leash, with 10 to 15 stations.

RALLY ADVANCE CLASS. All exercises are performed off leash with 12 to 17 stations. One jump is included.
