FUTURITY NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS & RULES

- The Futurity is sponsored by the American Whippet Club and is exclusively for the competition of puppies and juniors between 6 months and 18 months of age.
- The Futurity is open to all breeders of AKC registered whippets in good standing with the American Kennel Club and the American Whippet Club.
- Puppies eligible for the 2013 Futurity must be out of Futurity nominated bitches and whelped from October 18, 2011 to October 23, 2012, inclusive.
- Puppies eligible for the 2014 Futurity must be out of Futurity nominated bitches and whelped from October 24, 2012 to October 22, 2013, inclusive.
- The bitch must be nominated prior to whelping. The official Bitch Nomination Form, along with the fee of \$20 and copies of current CERF certificates for both the sire and dam, must be sent to the Futurity Chairman and postmarked prior to the whelping date. Copies of the Bitch Nomination Form are located on the AWC Website www.americanwhippetclub.net or can be obtained from the Futurity Chairman.
- CERF exams for both the sire and dam must have been completed before the breeding date. Copies of CERF Certificates or a copy of the application for a CERF Certificate (the actual exam paperwork marked normal in both eyes) must be submitted for both the sire and dam with the Bitch Nomination Form. If you submit exam paperwork with your Bitch Nomination, you must include CERF Certificates with the Litter Nomination Form. CERF examinations are valid for one year.
- If the sire or dam of the litter being nominated is over 8 years of age, a current CERF exam is not required for that dog. HOWEVER, the dog must have had and passed at least one CERF exam at age 8 or older. A copy of the last CERF Certificate must be submitted with the Bitch Nomination Form.
- Late bitch nominations are accepted if they are postmarked prior to the litter turning 6 weeks old. The fee for a late nomination is \$75. Breeders of late nominated bitches waive their right to nominate and vote for the Futurity Judge.
- The official Litter Nomination Form, along with the fee of \$25 and a four-generation pedigree, must be postmarked prior to the litter turning 3 months old.
- To enter the Futurity, puppies must be entered in a Regular Conformation Class and the appropriate Futurity Class as an 'additional' class at the AWC National they were nominated and are eligible for.
- Puppies are only eligible to be shown in one Futurity; the first Futurity when they are at least 6 months of age.
- Futurity Classes will be divided according to age and sex as follows:

Dogs 6-8 months
Dogs 8-10 months
Dogs 10-12 Months
Dogs 12-14 Months
Dogs 14-18 Months
Dogs 14-18 Months

- The winner of each class will compete for Best In Futurity.
- In the event that the date of the AWC National is later in April than the previous year, the age limit shall be increased and the nominees affected shall be eligible for competition in the 14-18 Month classes.
- The Futurity Judge is chosen by a two-step process by breeders of nominated bitches who are members in good standing of the American Whippet Club.

Step 1: Ballots are sent to the First AWC Member listed as breeder on the Bitch Nomination Form. For each nominated bitch, the breeder/ or breeders may submit one slate of two names. One ballot will be accepted for each bitch nominated. Once those breeders have voted (nominated), they may not vote (nominate) again during the current year. It is up to the breeder(s) to decide which litter they wish to be considered eligible on if they are listed as a breeder or co-breeder on other litters. All eligible breeders must nominate two (2) different names of any person with the qualification of "hands on experience" with the Whippet breed. These people must be in good standing with the AKC.

Step 2: Ballots are again sent to the First AWC Member listed as breeder on the Bitch Nomination Form. The breeder/or breeders will select two (2) names from the final list of a minimum of six (6) names. The nominees will be queried as to their willingness to judge the event by the sequence established in the balloting process. The alternate Judge will be selected by the second greatest number of votes. The nominee who accepts this nomination will be assigned as an alternate.

- "Late" bitch nominations forfeit their right to ballot for the Futurity Judge.
- Prize Money 35% of entry & nomination fees will be retained by the Futurity for expenses. 35% of the remainder will be given to the Best In Futurity winner. The remainder will be divided as follows: 40% for First Place, 30% for Second Place, 20% for Third Place and 10% for Fourth Place. Prize money shall be awarded to the breeder/breeders only. If an owner or exhibitor of the winning dog is not the breeder, and the breeder is not present, a check will be mailed directly to the breeder. It is between the breeders, exhibitors and owners to decide possession of any awards or cash prizes presented for any wins.
- Entry fees will be retained in the event a nominated bitch or puppy is found to be ineligible under any of the above conditions.

AWC VERSATILITY COMPETITION

The AWC Versatility Competition was developed to recognize Whippets that excel in four areas of competition: conformation, lure coursing, rally and agility. The competition is open to all Whippets entered in Triathlon/Versatility conformation, rally, agility, and lure coursing offered at the 2013 AWC National Specialty in Eugene, OR. Teams may enter both the Triathlon and the Versatility Competition.

First Place in Versatility: Large Rosette, Commemorative 10" plate • TJ Challenge Trophy • The Calvin Memorial Trophy Second through Tenth Place: Rosette, 8" plates

2013 AWC NATIONAL VERSATILITY COMPETITION RULES AND SCORING

Details of the Versatility competition rules and scoring can be found on the AWC national website (www.AWC2013.com). Teams will be given ranks based on their scores in the respective competitions. The ranks will be averaged with the lowest total average winning.

Conformation: The Triathlon/Versatility Conformation judge this year is Ms. Kristen Fredericks, Mariner Whippets.

Lure Coursing: The AWC National trial will be held on Sunday, April 21st and will be an ASFA trial. Scores from this trial will be used for Versatility.

Rally: Only ONE class is allowed for Versatility scoring and must be declared at the time of entry.

Agility: Dogs must enter both the Standard and JWW classes

All dogs must be handled by their owner in each event (including conformation).

VERSATILITY COMPETITION ENTRY FORM

The Versatility Competition Chairperson will handle the automatic entry in the Versatility conformation class. Entries in any regular conformation, rally and agility class and lure coursing stakes are the responsibility of the owner. Dogs must compete in each event, not just be entered.

NOTE: There will be a \$10 entry fee required for the Versatility competition. Please send this with the entry form below. This must be received by the entry deadline of March 20, 2013 or your dog will not be eligible to compete in the 2013 AWC Versatility Competition.

The AWC Triathlon competition was developed to recognize whippets that excel in three areas of competition: conformation, lure coursing and obedience. The 19th annual competition is open to all whippets entered in Triathlon/Versatility conformation, obedience and lure coursing at the 2013 AWC National Specialty in Eugene, OR. There will be 10 placement awards.

AWC NATIONAL TRIATHLON RULES AND SCORING

Details of the Triathlon rules and scoring can be found on the AWC national website (www.AWC2013.com). This year the Triathlon will be utilizing a ranking system identical to the Versatility competition in past years. Dogs will be given ranks based on their scores in the respective competitions. The ranks will be averaged with the lowest total average winning.

Conformation: The Triathlon/Versatility Conformation judge this year is Ms. Kristen Fredericks, Mariner Whippets.

Lure Coursing: The AWC National trial will be held on Sunday, April 21st and will be an ASFA trial. Scores from this trial will be used for the Triathlon.

Obedience: Only one obedience class will count toward the final Triathlon rank and that class **must be declared** on the entry form below. **NOTE**: If your dog has a title or legs toward a title you may not enter a lower class and utilize that score for the triathlon. If you do, your dog will be disqualified from the competition.

TRIATHLON ENTRY FORM

2013 AWC NATIONAL SPECIALTY CANINE GOOD CITIZEN TESTING RESERVATION FORM

Deadline: March 20, 2013

The CGC Program is a program that is designed to certify dogs that have the training and behaviors needed to be reliable, well-behaved members of their families and communities. This is not an obedience trial, it is much more relaxed.

We are asking that you pre-register so that we may schedule the testing when it is convenient. Fee: \$5.00 - Whippets & \$10 - Non-Whippets

RULES AND INFORMATION FOR ALL OWNERS:

- There is no age limit for dogs taking the CGC test. The exception to this is that with any AKC event they must be at least 6 months of age.
- All tests must be performed on leash. Dogs should wear well-fitting buckle or slip collars (including martingales) made of leather, fabric, or chain. Special training equipment such as harnesses, pinch collars and head collars are not permitted.
- Dogs with disabilities such as the loss of a leg, deafness, or blindness in one eye are welcome in the Canine Good Citizen Test.
- The 10 test items are:
 - ITEM 1: ACCEPTING A FRIENDLY STRANGER
 - ITEM 2: SITTING POLITELY FOR PETTING
 - ITEM 3: APPEARANCE AND GROOMING
 - ITEM 4: OUT FOR A WALK (WALKING ON A LOOSE LEASH)
 - ITEM 5: WALKING THROUGH A CROWD
 - ITEM 6: SIT AND DOWN ON COMMAND/STAYING IN PLACE
 - ITEM 7: COMING WHEN CALLED
 - ITEM 8: REACTION TO ANOTHER DOG
 - ITEM 9: REACTION TO DISTRACTIONS
 - ITEM 10: SUPERVISED SEPARATION

Owners of dogs that pass all 10 items of the CGC test may order an official CGC certificate from the AKC and will receive a qualifying ribbon from the AWC.

WHIPPET HEALTH FOUNDATION, INC. HEALTH CLINIC INFORMATION

The Whippet Health Foundation will be conducting health clinics in conjunction with the 2013 AWC National Specialty. OFA Eye Certification, BAER and cardiac echocardiogram clinics will be held as well as microchipping, AKC DNA and Myostatin testing. The Whippet Health Foundation will be subsidizing a portion of the per dog cost for BAER, cardiac, and myostatin testing for those dogs participating in the WHF database.

All test results subsidized by and released to the WHF Database will be public record.

HEALTH CLINIC SCHEDULE AT THE 2013 AWC NATIONAL

EYE CLINIC: Wednesday, April 24th This clinic will be conducted by Dr. Sarah Maxwell, ACVO. The cost is \$20 per dog. We will be offering the new OFA ECR (eye cert registry) test this year. Exam/interpretation/classification is identical to CERF. This test WILL fulfill the AWC Futurity requirement.

BAER HEARING CLINIC: Tuesday, April 23rd. This clinic will be conducted by Dr. Susanne Hughes. The cost is \$45 per dog for confidential results, \$25 for dogs whose test results will be submitted to the WHF database. Dr. Hughes will be scheduling all BAER appointments. There may be time later in the week for overflow testing.

CARDIAC ECHOCARDIOGRAM CLINIC: Monday April 22nd through Thursday, April 25th. This clinic will be conducted by Dr. Heidi Kellihan, ACVIM, one of the cardiologists from the University of Wisconsin, Madison. We will NOT be doing cardiac study rechecks this year. All exams will take approximately 15 to 20 minutes. The cost of the exam is \$225 for confidential results, \$175 for dogs whose test results will be submitted to the WHF database.

AKC DNA PROFILE TEST: (DNA cheek swab): \$30/sample. Swabs can either be mailed to you prior to the national or picked up in Eugene from Dr. Lisa Costello. She will be available to swab dogs for owners and to collect samples in Eugene. They can also be mailed to her but must be received by May 15th. **All swabs must be submitted after the national to AKC TOGETHER to qualify for this special rate**, do not send to AKC on your own or they will charge you full price!

MYOSTATIN DEFICIENCY TEST: \$48/sample (\$28 for database participants) Swabs can either be mailed prior to the national or picked up in Eugene from Dr. Lisa Costello. If you will not be attending the national, the swabs and payment can be mailed directly to Dr. Costello and will be submitted with all samples following the national specialty **(they must be submitted together).** These samples must reach her at the address on the health clinic sign up form no later than **May 15th**, **2013**. If you will not be attending the AWC national and need to order sample collection kits directly, call 1-800-625-0874, or email *contact@vetdnacenter.com*.

MICROCHIPPING: \$30 PER DOG. This service will be done by Dr. Hughes and will include an AKC ISO Chip as well as the registration. Dr. Hughes will schedule a time with you after your health clinic registration is received.
