BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records.

BEST PUPPY IN THE REGULAR PUPPY CLASSES

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

STUD DOG. For Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class. Entry fee is \$22.00 for the Unit, or \$18.00 as an additional class.

BROOD BITCH. For Bitches and two of their produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class. Entry fee is \$22.00 for the Unit, or \$18.00 as an additional class.

BRACE CLASS (Two dogs, identical ownership). The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be a part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". Full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes - "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be so designated "Brace #1", Brace #2", etc.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, or Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitchs making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

PARADE OF VETERANS: Open to dogs and bitches eight years of age and older on the day of the show. Entry Fee is \$16.00. Dogs need not be Champions to enter. Dogs entered in this class need not be entered in a regular class at this Show. Each Veteran will receive a Rosette with name inscribed.


