

# A Presentation on Fresh & Frozen Semen Technologies featuring Stan Carter, DVM

Thursday April 14, 2005 3:30pm at Purina Farms Visitors Center Auditorium

Stan Carter, DVM graduated from the University of Missouri College of Veterinary Medicine in 1985. Dr. Carter spent many years in private practice as owner of All Creatures Animal Hospital, served as veterinarian in charge of Purina's research and development facility, and recently became regional medical director for Banfield, the Pet Hospital.

Dr. Carter is an avid show enthusiast, finishing more than twenty basenji champions and multiple specialty winners. He served on the National basenji board and as health chairman for more than a decade, and is past National specialty show chairman and Sweepstakes judge.

Dr. Carter has a special interest in reproduction and founded Canine Reproductive Technologies in 2001, a frozen semen collection and storage facility. New technologies such as frozen semen represent tremendous potential benefits for our future dogs, both in the show ring and for health. We can virtually stop time on the male side of the breeding equation, which greatly increases our genetic pool. Dr. Carter will present a straightforward, breeder-friendly talk on the topics of fresh and frozen semen technologies.

BRACE CLASS: For two Rottweilers that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. Dogs need not be entered in another class. Entry fee for Brace as a Unit is \$18.00. If either dog is not entered in another class, the fee for the Unit is \$28.00.

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, not one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

ARC SELECT AWARDS: All dogs eligible for the Best of Breed Competition shall be considered for these awards. In this stake there will be 43 cash wins, the three individuals (the breeder, the owner, and the owner of the sire at the time of nomination) partaking of these awards, for a total of 88 monetary awards, won by 40 different Rottweilers.

Ten Percent shall be deducted from the total nomination and entry fee purse to be used for Futurity expenses. This will be known as the General Expense Fund. This Fund shall be used to cover all expenses incurred by the Futurity Stake, i.e., judges, printing, mailing, etc. Since the administrative and judging expense will vary from year to year, excess in any given year shall be carried for use in future years.

Twenty-five percent shall be deducted from the total nomination and entry fee purse to be awarded as follows: 15% to the Best in Futurity, 5% to the Best Senior in Futurity, and 5% to the Best Junior in Futurity. The 15% Best in Futurity award will be divided: 50% to the recorded breeder of the winner and 50% to the recorded owner of the winner. The 5% awarded to the Best Junior and Best Senior in Futurity is to be divided: 50% to the recorded breeder, 30% to the recorded owner and 20% to the owner of the sire or owner of the frozen semen at the time of mating, for each winner.

The remaining 65 percent of the total purse shall be divided according to the percent of the total entry represented by the number of dogs entered in each class.

Monetary Awards will be given to the handler presenting the puppy in the ring for the four class placements. The Best Junior, Best Senior and Best in Futurity monetary awards will be given to the breeder who nominated the litter, the sire's owner who is listed first on the litter nomination and the puppy owner who is listed first on the individual puppy nomination. The monetary award will be mailed to them should they not be present. Monetary awards, which are provided for but cannot be given, whatever the reason, shall be applied to the total Futurity Stake for the following year.

# GENERAL INFORMATION AND SHOW RULES NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. Single copies of Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Junior Showmanship Guidelines, Obedience Regulations and Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline may be obtained free from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606-3390.

ALL ENTRIES (Conformation, Obedience and Rally) will be from 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. Consult the judging program for times of judging. Dogs must be present for their scheduled judging time and may be excused as soon as they are no longer needed for competition. Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms and photocopies of entries without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

NO ENTRY shall be made or accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED, cancelled, altered or substituted after entries have closed, except as provided for in Ch. 11, Sec.6, AKC rules.

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES: Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the start of judging. (Ch. 14, Sec. 6, AKC rules)
