While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class. Entry fee \$25.00 (Stud Dog and two or more of its Get), if Stud Dog is not entered in one of the Regular Classes, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class. Entry fee \$15.00 for Stud Dog Class as an additional class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: For Brood Bitches and two or more but not more than four of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition, or some other non-regular class. Entry fee \$25.00 (Brood Bitch and two or more of its Produce), if Brood Bitch is not entered in one of the Regular Classes, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class. Entry fee \$15.00 for Brood Bitch Class as an additional class.

BRACE CLASS: Two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog, which is to be part of a Brace, is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for Best of Breed Competition, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." 
