The Bearded Collie Club of America, Inc. will award at its National Specialty a three point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

The Bearded Collie Club of America, Inc. will award at its National Specialty a three point major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Ch. 11, Sec. 1)

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

STUD DOG CLASS BROOD BITCH CLASS BRACE CLASS

AMATEUR-OWNER-HANDLER – The Amateur-Owner-Handler Class shall be for dogs that are at least 6 mos of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Ch. 11, Sec. 13).

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES - For dogs that are:

- · Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show;
- Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show;
- Individually registered with The American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show;
- Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as the date of the closing of entries for the show.

The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES – For dogs and bitches, six months of age or over, that have been neutered or spayed. The dog and bitch winning these classes are *not* eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

PERFORMANCE CLASSES – For dogs and bitches, 6 months of age and over, that have earned at least one title in any AKC Companion or Performance Event (Agility, Herding, Obedience, Rally or Tracking). Dogs entered in these classes must not have been neutered or spayed. By virtue of winning these classes, the dog and bitch are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

- VETERAN CLASSES For dogs and bitches seven years of age and older. In accordance with Chapter 11, Section 8, veteran dogs and bitches may be spayed or neutered at specialty shows. First place winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes will compete for Best Veteran Dog and Best Veteran Bitch, to be judged after Best of Breed. All winners of the Veteran classes are eligible for Best of Breed.
- BEST OF BREED COMPETITION Undefeated dogs ONLY are eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Bitches do not need to present for an armband check at the beginning of Best of Breed competition, as Best of Breed Dog and Bitch judging will be scheduled at different times. All Best of Breed Dogs will be judged to their entirety; followed by all Best of Breed Bitches. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

GRAND CHAMPION COMPETITION - The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition:

- 1. Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Best of Variety class.
- 2. Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed.
- 3. Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition. (Altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible.)
- 4. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition.

At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to:

- Best of Breed or Variety
 Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Variety
- Select DogSelect Bitch

Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed competition.

- **AWARDS OF MERIT (AOM)** Award of Merit rosettes may be awarded to ten percent of the Best of Breed entry including the winners of the non-regular classes who are eligible for best of breed at each national specialty. The rosettes will not be numbered. The following are not eligible for an Award of Merit: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch.
- STUD DOG CLASS For Stud Dogs and two (2) of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes or Veterans Classes, (provided the Get has not been spayed or neutered), or Best of Breed Competition.
- BROOD BITCH CLASS For Brood Bitches and two (2) of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes or Veterans Classes, (provided the Produce has not been spayed or neutered), or Best of Breed Competition.
 - NOTE: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that a "castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."
- BRACE CLASS A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1"; "Brace No. 2", etc. Please submit Brace entries together.

All entries in the Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class in this show at the appropriate entry fee. Champions of record may be entered in Sweepstakes. The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age but less than six months on the day of the event. Entry Fee: \$20. Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition will be offered in a separate ring(s) from the regular class judging in order to avoid delays in the judging of regular classes. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition.

Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule. if offered.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. *Professional handlers are defined* as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.

Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes or Veterans Classes, (provided the Get has not been spayed or neutered), or Best of Breed Competition.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – For Brood Bitches and two (2) of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Produce must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes or Veterans Classes, (provided the Produce has not been spayed or neutered), or Best of Breed Competition.

NOTE: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that a "castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to dogs six months of age and under 20 months of age on the day of the show. Dogs entered in Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in a regular class at this show with "Sweepstakes" marked in the Additional Classes box.

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs 7 years and older on the day of the show. Neutered or spayed dogs are eligible to compete in Veteran Sweepstakes. Dogs entered in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in a regular class at this show.
